<p>Skillset description</p>	<p>This skill set develops the core knowledge and practical skills required to assist clients to self-administer medication.</p> <p>Total units of competency: 2</p> <p><b>HLTAAP001 Recognise healthy body systems</b> This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to work with basic information about the human body and to recognise and promote ways to maintain healthy functioning of the body.</p> <p><b>HLTHPS006 Assist clients with medication</b> This unit prepares students with the skills and knowledge required to prepare for and provide medication assistance and complete medication documentation. It also involves supporting a client to self-administer medication.</p>
<p>Target Group</p>	<p>This skill set has been endorsed by industry as suitable for individuals who hold a qualification at Certificate III level or higher in an area involving provision of direct client care and support.</p>
<p>Delivery</p>	<p>Contextualised to the Community Services sector. Delivery can be customised to meet the requirements of industry employers.
