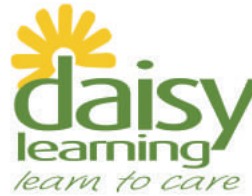

Duration

Skill Set description

This skill set develops the core knowledge and practical skills required to assist clients to self-administer medication.

HLTAAP001 Recognise healthy body systems

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to work with basic information about the human body and to recognise and promote ways to maintain healthy functioning of the body.

HLTHPS006 Assist clients with medication

This unit prepares students with the skills and knowledge required to prepare for and provide medication assistance and complete medication documentation. It also involves supporting a client to self-administer medication.
